History

Marc Colin was born in 1944 and created his domain at the late 1970s with his wife Michèle. They took the vineyards stemming from several generations of Colin and Ponavoy families, some parcels of land are owned by the family for more than a century. They grew approximately 6 hectares of vineyards in the village of Chassagne-Montrachet, Saint-Aubin and continued to develop the domain during 1980s and 1990s. Today, Caroline, Joseph and Damien, three of their children, lead the domain which extends over 19 hectares and includes 26 appellations of the villages of Saint-Aubin, Chassagne-Montrachet, Puligny-Montrachet and Santenay.
