History

From a long line of winemakers and coopers based in Meursault, Sylvain took over the estate in 1982 with his wife, on the property where his grandparents used to live. Over the years, the estate has expanded with the acquisition of new vineyards, as well as the modernization and enlargement of the existing winery buildings.

The top value of the domaine
Traditional vinification allowing natural fermentation to develop without introduced yeasts, with careful monitoring of each wine as it ages.

The wines
The planting density on the plots varies from 9,000 to 11,000 vines per hectare. .

Two pruning methods: Cordon de Royat (with two main spurs), and single Guyot.
