Since 30 years, Hélène and François are interested in the domaine. Now François is the winemaker.

The top value of the domaine

No new oak to avoid hiding the typically of the Terroir.

The grapes are pressed in an old press of 1951; no new oak is used. Wines are bottled non fined and non filtered.
